Attention is invited to the reference (1) cited, wherein the Pharmacy Council of India has informed that the approval of the PCI is essential before starting D.Pharm / B.Pharm Course and to conduct the courses u/s 12 of Pharmacy Act, 1948 and that the said policy will be strictly adhered to from the academic year 2010-2011 onwards. However, it is observed that many of the Colleges are running the Courses and students admitted into the Colleges even without obtaining approval from the PCI.

In this connection, I am directed to request the College to intimate to this Office the present status of approval of the Pharmacy Council of India, alongwith documentary evidence, to conduct D.Pharm / B.Pharm Courses in the College on or before 30.04.2011 so as to take further necessary action in the matter.

The matter may be treated as **MOST URGENT.**
