Guidelines for Student Teacher Category

- The Project Portfolio should be submitted along with the Detailed Entry Template.
- The Project topic should be an original idea of the participant.
- It can be either group project or individual project.
- The project should aim at extension of classroom learning of the students to real life situation. (ie application of the core concepts and making real world connections)
- The Project should involve students in problem solving investigations that culminate in realistic products. (For eg – a newsletter that can be distributed/ web site/ presentations that can be shared with a larger audience/ a letter to the editor, posters, banners etc).
- The Project should include the following:
 - A detailed Lesson Plan that includes the Project Summary, Learning Objectives, Assessment procedures and Implementation Procedure and Resources planned/implemented.
 - A guideline (Multimedia Presentation/Newsletter) for the students describing the steps to follow.
 - Samples of Student Work planned/implemented (Multimedia / Newsletter/Poster/Web site)
 - Assessment tools
